

Jamboree Trip Code of Conduct

- 1) I will follow the Scout Oath & Law at all times while on our Jamboree trip, knowing that I represent Scouting to all around me.
- 2) I will always follow the Buddy System and be with at least 1 other Scout.
- 3) I will set a good example by keeping myself neatly dressed and presentable and will wear my Jamboree credentials at all times.
- 4) I will attend all scheduled programs and participate as required in cooperation with other unit members and leaders.
- 5) In consideration of other unit participants, I agree to follow the bedtime and sleep schedule of the unit.
- 6) I will be responsible for keeping my tent and personal gear clean and neat and labeling all personal gear.
- 7) I will adhere to all Jamboree recycling policies and regulations and will not litter.
- 8) I understand that the possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs is prohibited at all times during our trip.
- 9) I understand that serious and/or repetitive behavior violations (including cheating, stealing, dishonesty, fighting, and cursing) may result in expulsion from the Jamboree or serious disciplinary action and loss of privileges.
- 10) I understand that gambling of any form is prohibited.
- 11) I understand that possession of lasers of any type, or possession or detonation of fireworks is prohibited.

I have read and discussed the Jamboree Code of Conduct with my parent(s)/ guardian(s). By signing below, we indicate our understanding of the progressive discipline steps should I not follow this Code at all times during our trip.

Any first offense: Scoutmaster's Conference to review how the situation violated the Scout Oath, Law, and/or Jamboree Trip Code of Conduct; and to set expectations for further conduct.

Any second offense: Scoutmaster's Conference (possibly involving Jamboree Unit Commissioner or other staff) and parent(s)/guardian(s) will be called.

Any third offense: May be grounds for expulsion – Scoutmaster's Conference with Jamboree Unit Commissioner or other staff and call to the parent(s)/ guardian(s). The Scout may be dismissed from the event and it will become the duty of the parent/guardian to retrieve their Scout.

I also understand that some infractions may be considered major and as such, may be treated as a second or third offense immediately.
