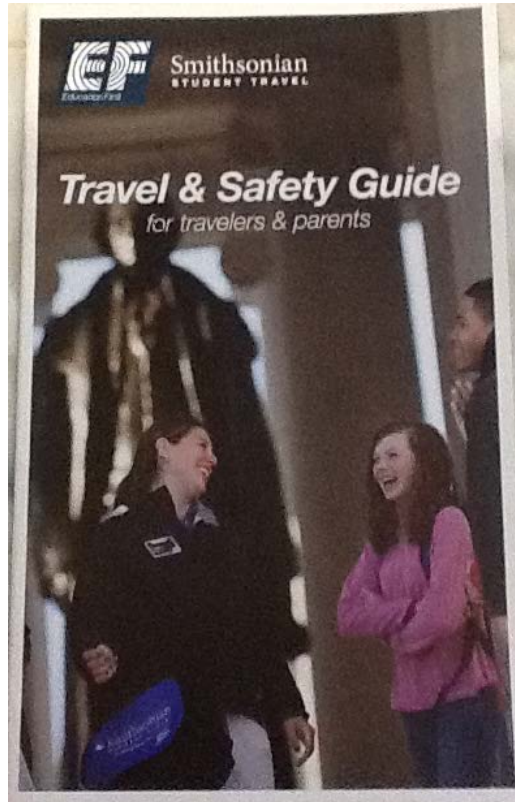


Travel and Safety Guide

Patch Set Issued to Participants

- There should be two of every patch issued.
- The Official 2013 National Jamboree patches were issued at the March meeting
- Only members of the Order of the Arrow were issued the two piece blue lodge flap set
- The patrol patches vary by patrol.

Uniform Layout

Youth should wear their rank as always on their left pocket.

Boys and adults may wear any square knots they have earned and their Arrow of Light just as on their home troop uniform.

Only OA members have blue bear lodge flap set for right pocket.

Please leave space between "Boy Scouts of America" and Jamboree patch for name tag.

All participants will be issued a troop neckerchief that is to be worn at all times with the Class A uniform. Troop A302 is royal blue and B340 is forest green. These will be handed out in Washington DC. Crew F403 is neon green and has already been issued.

Troop B340 has yellow parachord woggles that are the official troop neckerchief slide. Crew F403 has multi-neon colored woggles for their slides.

Left Sleeve Layout

Only youth or adults with a leadership position in the troop should wear the Position patch below the troop number patch. If they have been through the appropriate training for that position, they may wear the trained emblem below that just as in their home unit. If the youth does not have a leadership position in B340, then no trained emblem is worn.



Delicate Item Wash Bag

Please purchase one of these and include in your gear. Please sew something onto it that is personally recognizable. The example for Mr. Brown is a 1999 World Jamboree patch as he would most likely be the only person on the trip with that patch. It doesn't have to be a Boy Scout patch. Thread or embroidery would work too. The idea is to be able to wash a large number of green Scout socks and underwear in one washer and dryer and have boys quickly find their bag. These may be purchased at Dollar Tree, Wal-Mart, K-Mart, Shopko, etc for generally a dollar or two if not less.
